Before boarding your first flight, you will need to fill out a Passenger Locator Form (PLF) for each of the countries you are traveling through. For example, if you have a layover in Brussels and Kigali, you will fill out a PLF for both of those two countries. Note-Read through your flight itinerary carefully to see the countries you are traveling through. All Delta / KLM and United / Brussels flights go through Kigali, Rwanda.

TIME FRAME

The PLF forms need to be completed after you have had your COVID-19 PCR test, but before the day of travel. Typically, you should complete these forms the day before you leave the USA.

NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION

- 1. Passport
- 2. Covid Vaccination Card (if you have had a Covid vaccine)
- 3. Details of your negative PCR COVID Test. Note- your covid test, MUST be a PCR test.
- 4. Flight itinerary. Note- If the form asks for a seat # and you do not yet have that information, you can "guess" (e.g. 27c).
- 5. Where you are staying in Uganda.

SUBMIT AND PRINT FOR YOUR RECORDS

After filling out the form, print the completed form or certificate and email a copy to yourself.

If you receive a completion email, print the email and any attached certificate showing you completed the PLF document.

Bring the printed PLF form with you to the airport.
